
Introductions – Participants introduced themselves and explained a little about their participation in

Tour of East Cherry Creek Valley Reverse Osmosis Plant – The group toured the plant and learned about the processes and the system that pumps water 30 miles from the plant to the residents in the Cherry Creek watershed. Brine from the plant is injected 10,000 feet into bedrock.
